A .22LR Pistol/rifle is used by the student for the pre-course shooting test on Friday. Bring one box of .22LR ammunition and your own firearm. If you do not own a .22LR Pistol/rifle, let the Instructor know so one can be provided for you. For the Pistol Course shooting, bring 100 rounds of ammo and your own pistol (.22LR preferred). Ear and eye protection is required on the range.

You will also need pencils/pens/highlighters & note paper. Students should bring snacks, drinks; there is a pop machine and refrigerator at the clubhouse. Coffee and donuts will be provided Saturday for all Courses; bring a sack lunch & dinner.

There is no smoking in the classroom or on the firing line. There will be breaks so you may go outside to smoke. The firing range is outside; please wear appropriate clothing for the weather conditions.

Pre-Registration is required. To be considered registered, please fill out the forms and return with full payment to hold your place in the class. Mail ASAP! First registrations received get 1st choice of openings. You will get confirmation that your registration has been received. If you fail to show without canceling, ½ of fee is forfeited. A student canceling within 7 days of the course will receive all but \$10 of the fee to cover the background check. If the minimum # of students needed to hold a class are not signed up by the Wednesday before class, it will be canceled and class fee returned or held for a later class. All persons attending an NRA shooting instruction course must pass a criminal background check. If the applicant fails the background check, admission to the class will be denied and the class fee less \$10 will be returned. The shooting range location is at the Lima SABRES Shooting Association, 5090 Hanthorn Road, east of the Allen County Airport. The Friday pre-course testing takes place at SABRES Rental Range. Guns & Ammo stay locked in your vehicle!

NRA Instructor Training Program

Pre-Course Questionnaire

Thank you for your interest in the NRA Instructor Training Program. The goal of this program is to develop instructors to teach NRA Basic Firearm Training Courses according to the lesson plans and training standards of the National Rifle Association. This program is not designed to prepare you to teach other firearm training courses (such as law enforcement, security, or hunter safety courses), nor to prepare you to develop firearm-training courses of your own.

The NRA Instructor Training Course is designed to teach you how to teach others to shoot using NRA lesson plans and training methods. The course is not designed to improve your shooting skills. Possession of basic firearm safety and/or shooting skills is a prerequisite for certification as an NRA Instructor. You will be asked to demonstrate your firearm background through participation in pre-course assessment exercises.

A complete NRA Instructor Training Course consists of two parts. The first is basic instructor training, which consists of six hours of instruction. The second part is discipline-specific instructor training, which consists of an additional ten and a half to fourteen hours of instruction per discipline (except for Home Firearm Safety, which has an additional five hours of instruction). For example, an NRA Instructor Training Course in rifle, pistol, and shotgun lasts at least 40 hours.

At the beginning of the NRA Instructor Training Course, you will receive from your training counselor the *NRA Instructor's Guide* in a three-ring binder, the appropriate NRA Course Outlines and Lesson Plans for the disciplines you wish to teach, the appropriate NRA basic student handbook, and other materials used in NRA basic courses.

The NRA Training Counselor who conducts your course will make a recommendation to NRA concerning your certification based on an evaluation of your knowledge, skill, and attitude. You will be asked to demonstrate your organizational and teaching skills through participation in several practical exercises during the course of your training. You will also be asked to complete an instructor certification examination. A minimum score of 90 percent is required to certify instructor applicants (85 percent for assistant and apprentice instructor applicants). Attendance at the course, or a passing grade on the examination, does not guarantee that you will receive the recommendation of the NRA Training Counselor.

Instructor certification involves a commitment to conduct NRA Basic Firearm Training Courses on an annual basis in each discipline group (rifle, pistol, shotgun) in which you hold instructor ratings. NRA instructor ratings are valid for one year. Renewal of your certification will be contingent upon your annual activity in conducting NRA Basic Firearm Training courses, and your participation in periodic recertification activities.

Undersigned agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend any and all course instructors (hereinafter referred to as "Instructor") from all fault, liability, costs, expenses, claims, demands or lawsuits arising out of, related to or connected with, Undersigned's presence at and/or participation in the course of instruction, the discharge of firearms by Undersigned, Undersigned's presence on or use of the range, buildings, land and premises ("Premises"), and, any and all acts or omissions of Undersigned.

Undersigned furthermore waives for himself and for his executors, personal representatives, administrators, assignees, heirs and next of kin, all rights and claims for damages, losses, demands and any other actions or claims whatsoever, which he may have or which may arise against Instructor (including but not limited to the death of Undersigned and/or any and all injuries, damages or illness suffered by Undersigned or Undersigned's property), which may, in any way whatsoever, arise out of, be related to or connected with: the course of instruction, the Premises, including any latent defect in the Premises, Undersigned's presence on or use of said Premises, Undersigned's property (whether or not entrusted to Instructor), and, the discharge of firearms. Instructor shall not be liable for, and Undersigned, on behalf of himself and on behalf of his executors, personal representatives, administrators, assignees, heirs and next of kin, hereby expressly releases the Instructor from any and all such claims and liabilities.

Undersigned hereby expressly assumes the risk of taking part in the course for instruction in firearms and taking part in the activities on the Premises which include, but are not limited to, instruction in the use of firearms, the discharge of firearms and the firing of live ammunition.

Undersigned hereby acknowledges and agrees that Undersigned has read this instrument and understands its terms and is executing this instrument voluntarily. Undersigned furthermore hereby acknowledges and agrees that he has read, understands and will abide by all range rules and procedures and any other rules and procedures stated by the Instructor.

Undersigned expressly agrees that this instrument is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by law, and that if any provision of this instrument is held invalid or otherwise unenforceable, the enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not be impaired thereby. No remedy conferred by any of the specific provisions of this instrument is intended to be exclusive of any other remedy, and each and every remedy shall be cumulative and shall be in addition to every other remedy now or hereafter existing at law or in equity or by statute or otherwise. The election of any one or more remedies hereunder by the Instructor shall not constitute any waiver of Instructor's right to pursue other available remedies. This instrument binds Undersigned and his executors, personal representatives, administrators, assignees, heirs and next of kin.
